



TENNIS

The International Tennis Federation (ITF) will be adopted for the competition. However, in matters not provided for in the rules of the competition, decisions shall rest with the WNCAA Ground rules.

GROUND RULES

1. TEAM COMPOSITION & FIELDING OF PLAYERS

- 1.1. The event is participated by the Juniors Division.
- 1.2. Each must have a minimum of four (4) and maximum of six (6) players.
- 1.3. No repeat of players in every team tie.
- 1.4. The Official Entry Form must be filled-up with all the matches and submitted to the Tournament Referee.
- 1.5. The Official Entry Form must be filled-up with all the matches and submitted to the Tournament Referee.
- 1.6. Only physically present players can be entered in the Official Entry Form. Once the Tournament Referee makes the call for the particular tie, both coaches/team captains must submit the Official Entry Form within 5 minutes.
- 1.7. If there are only 3 physically present players, the team automatically forfeits the second singles – giving the other team a 1-0 lead.
- 1.8. If there is only 2 or less physically present player, the team automatically forfeits the tie – but the first singles match will still be played.

2. TEAM UNIFORM

- 2.1. All players are required to use their official school playing uniform with family name at the back and WNCAA logo on front at the upper right corner.

3. TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- 3.1. The sequence for the mini Davis Cup format as follows:
1st match – Singles

2nd match – Doubles

3rd match – Singles

3.2. The teams will play a singles round-robin format.

3.3. The team with the best record based on the win-loss card will be declared Champion and the rest will follow.

3.4. The scoring system will be straight-8 games DUECE with tiebreak at 7-games all. No grace period.

3.5. The first matches will start at 9am and the next matches will be on a Followed-By system. All technical inquiries including schedules – will be directed to the Commissioner _____/ Commissioner _____.

4. **RESOLUTION OF TIES**

4.1. In case of a two-way tie after the round robin format, the win-over-the-other rule will be applied.

4.2. In case of 3 or more ties, the quotient system will break the tie (matches won over matches lost).
